



LICENSE YOUR DOG.
PA BUREAU OF DOG LAW ENFORCEMENT

WITHOUT IDENTIFICATION A LOST DOG
may never make it home.

License your dog by January 1st: www.licenseyourdogpa.com

Your best friend's best chance to make it home safely is to be properly licensed.

All dogs 3 months of age or older
Are required by Pennsylvania law to have a current dog license.

Failure to have your dog licensed may result in a fine of up to \$300 (per dog).

How much does a license cost?

Annual license fees are as follows:

General:

Dogs that are spayed or neutered..... \$6.50

Dogs not spayed or neutered \$8.50

**Senior citizens (65 years of age and older)
or persons with proof of disability:**

Dogs that are spayed or neutered..... \$4.50

Dogs not spayed or neutered \$6.50
